Learn about the Anza colonizing expedition in 1775. In late fall, Anza passed through the Tucson area with about 300 people, a lot of cattle, horses, and mules on his way to create a settlement at San Francisco. There were some twenty seven camps made in October and November in Arizona, from Nogales to Yuma. There were no wagons; everything was unloaded each night from a mule and reloaded the next morning. Some of the more interesting camp stories along the way will be highlighted in the talk, and the route will be illustrated with maps.
